7 FURLONGS. (1:20²) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Chicago H.FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 each by 12:00 noon, Friday June 16. Weights to be announced Saturday June 17. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. The maximum number of starters for the Chicago Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights with consideration to the scale of weights for age. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay the entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. (Clear 82)

FINLEY'SLUCKYCHARM set the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn then drew clear in the stretch under a steady drive. IVY BELL stalked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. MAYLA chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. SHE MABEE WILD came in at the start, swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. KATHBALLU was well placed early, shifted into the three path in the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. COVEY TRACE tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn and was empty down the lane. ATHENA was never a threat. SWEETGRASS was bumped at the start, fanned into the five path in the turn. STAGEPLAY shifted into the four path in the turn and was no factor. PLEASANT TALES was done early and eased in the stretch.
