

1½ MILE. (Turf) (1:47³) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 Commonwealth Cup S.FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination. \$1150 to pass the entry box, \$1150 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last. Supplemental nominations of \$2500 each will be accepted by the usual time of entry with all other fees due as noted. Weights: Three-Year-Olds 120 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (May), by Pulpit - Salute by Unbridled. Trainer Claude R. McGaughey III. Bred by Phipps Stable (KY).

MR SPEAKER rated close up while saving ground, shifted out four wide leaving the quarter pole, leveled off nicely inside the three sixteenths, forged to command after being roused once right handed in mid stretch, kicked clear and was under steady hand urging to the wire. LEGENDARY (GB) broke sharply and prompted the pace outside of CUT TO ORDER, applied more pressure when asked mid way on the final turn, assumed command past the quarter pole, briefly spurted clear when put to a drive soon after, met the winner's bid heading to the furlong grounds and gave way grudgingly. EL JEFE GRANDE saved ground off the early pace, came under a ride around the final turn, eased off the inside in upper stretch, split foes late and kept on willingly. UP WITH THE BIRDS, three wide between rivals early, was rated back after being brushed entering the first turn, raced three wide outside a pair of rivals down the backstretch, was put to strong ride leaving the three eighths but failed to seriously respond. CUT TO ORDER cleared early and secured the inside, set a slow pace under some rating, handled outside pressure after a half mile, ceded command nearing the lane, stayed willingly to the three sixteenths then succumbed. TALK SHOW MAN broke a step slow, was sent up four wide into the first turn, dropped in a path and moved to a stalking spot five furlongs out, failed to kick on when under heavy pressure past the three eighths and gave way. GOLDEN GLINT steadied when in a bit tight between rivals heading towards the first turn, continued between foes down the backstretch, had no response leaving the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and faded.
