1 1/4 MILE. (1:47) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 Discovery S.FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$2,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2017 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake lifetime allowed 4 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2017 or two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance in 2017 allowed 6 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance in 2017 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 11, 2017 with 13 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (Clear 55)

Bay Colt, (Mar), by Posse - We Kept Her by Victory Gallop. Trainer Rudy R. Rodriguez. Bred by Colts Neck Stable & Alan Goldberg (NY).

CONTROL GROUP coaxed from the gate, established the front and showed the way from the two path through the first turn before settling in hand three wide down the backstretch in a comfortable rhythm through sensible splits, began to widen away under very light coaxing into the far turn, continued to widen through that bend and swung three to four wide into upper stretch, got roused at the three-sixteenths, drifted out briefly under a near sided stick while holding well and clear to the finish kept to task. SENIOR INVESTMENT crossed to be just off the inside after the start, raced detached at the tail of the field in tandem with BONUS POINTS early on, began a steady advance on the rest of the group up front from the five eighths to be among rivals midway on the far turn when put to coaxing in the two path, angled out five wide into upper stretch moving into contention straightened away for home, offered up a mild kick to chase the winner home and cut into his margin, unable to reel him in, while well clear for the place honors. BONUS POINTS broke out a step at the start brushing lightly with CONTROL GROUP while being corrected, crossed directly to the inside, raced detached at the rear of the field in concert with the aforementioned rival settling four wide down the backstretch, began to advance with that foe five furlongs from home, came under coaxing caught up to the rest of the field at the three-eighths, went five to six wide for home and improved position in the late stages to secure the show honors. CAN YOU DIGGIT two to three wide in pursuit, tucked inside at the half mile pole, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, swung three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SPIETH four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing tucked three wide at the seven-sixteenths, cornered four wide into upper stretch and tired. TRUE TIMBER raced inside through the opening bend before tracking the leader three then two wide in closest aim, came under a ride three furlongs from home, went four wide at the head of the stretch and faltered.
