1 MILE. (1:32) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 Dwyer S. (Grade III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The guaranteed purse of \$300,000 will be divided accordingly; \$165,000 to the owner of the winner, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth, \$9,000 to fifth, \$6,000 to sixth with the remaining \$6,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races in 2018, 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2018, 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 23, 2018 with 18 nominations. (Clear 77)

FIRENZE FIRE away well from the starting gate, unlike several others, raced at a considerable distance from off the rail throughout, steadily advanced on the front runners towards path four during the run around the bend, struck the front by a narrow margin right after three-quarters had been completed, responded when given his cue kicking away from the competition, enough so as to begin the final furlong in possession of a healthy margin, drew off smartly the remainder of the way home, kept to some urging to the end. SEVEN TRUMPETS was pushed in slightly right after bobbling at the break, cut over to the inside route, fought the rider by pulling hard on the bit during the initial stages, was gradually shifted into path two after stepping onto the turn, got roused working his way into path five during the stretch run, overtook MENDELSSOHN to garner the place. MENDELSSOHN secured a forward position for himself after losing his footing springing from the gate, was three wide pressing NOBLE INDY for command on the backstretch, and in path two once the twosome made their way onto the turn, spun into the lane directly alongside the nemesis and got called upon, had no chance to cement itself to the top once the eventual winner got going, drifted steadily into path four en route to losing out on second. RUGBYMAN was forced in getting squeezed at the start, resulting in the pilot grabbing hold, settled into path three by the top of the turn, got called upon at the five-sixteenths marker, commenced the stretch approximately four wide and with the rider applying strong pressure on the right rein, failed to make any headway during the ensuing furlong, lugged in several paths from midstretch to the sixteenth pole, still under the previously-described hold in addition to a left side whip, continued to not make any headway and had to settle for the last major check. SEAHENGE pursued the front runners travelling three wide on the turn, made no impact. FIXEDINCOME LARRY took an awkward step in the shadow of the starting gate, was in path four departing the backstretch, angled a bit wider for the drive home, had no rally. NOBLE INDY came in sharply at the start, inducing RUGBYMAN towards the inside too, was pulled away from that opponent and after having done so, went on to assume the top, mildly urged, got joined by MENDELSSOHN, sparred with foe taking the two path on the backstretch, cut over to the rail at the top of the bend, got headed at the top of the lane then steadily backed away.
