CHOCOLATE MARTINI moved in early, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled last but one, was roused in the three path early on the far turn, angled five wide late on that bend, rallied outside under a left-handed whip, closed well to get the lead at the sixteenth-pole and just held off the runner-up under strong urging. ESKIMO KISSES dropped well behind early, lagged at the rear while saving ground, angled three wide outside the five-sixteenths, rallied six wide into the stretch under the whip, closed well on the outside, drifted out a bit near the sixteenth-pole, surged at the winner coming to the wire and just missed. WONDER GADOT went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused outside the half-mile pole, went four wide while ridden along on the far turn, chased the leader in the stretch, kept on well to the wire and earned the show. CLASSY ACT went to the front, raced in the two path on the first turn, set a clear pace through quick fractions, extended the advantage in the two path on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, drifted out in upper stretch then was put to a right-handed whip, was collared at the sixteenth-pole then outfinished. SHE'S A JULIE went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked in the three path on the far turn, chased the leader into the final sixteenth and was out-kicked. SAGUARO ROW brushed the inside of the gate at the start and was last away, became rank behind AMERICA'S TALE while under stout restraint on the first turn, settled more kindly on the backstretch, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. AMERICA'S TALE raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, was rated in the second flight, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths, dropped back along the rail on the far turn and faltered then was eased but walked off.
