1 MILE. (Turf) (1:31¹) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Forbidden Apple S. FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse will be divided as follows: \$87,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth, \$3,000 to sixth with the remaining \$3,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over in 2017-18 allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race in 2017-18, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2018, 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2018, 8 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, June 30, 2018 with 32 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.) (Rail at 27 feet). (Clear 86)

Chestnut Colt, (Apr), by English Channel - Mystic Chant by Unbridled's Song. Trainer Linda Rice. Bred by Stonewall Farm (NY).

VOODOO SONG veered in at the start forcing OFFERING PLAN to be taken in hand in behind and bumping with DISCO PARTNER, established the front and raced in hand inside, pulling on the bit under the restraint of the rider early on until settling better with six furlongs to go, showed the way through swift splits in a comfortable rhythm, remained patiently handled until put to coaxing nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to the eighth pole, held well and safe to prevail on the wire. PROJECTED (GB) three wide in the clear in mid pack, early on, tucked to the two path behind cover five furlongs out, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch and rallied in tandem with OFFERING PLAN to his outside offering up a mild kick to secure the place honors. OFFERING PLAN steadied briefly at the start as VOODOO SONG veered in front, settled three wide behind the cover of his barn mate PROJECTED while near the rear, raced briefly in the clear as that rival tucked five furlongs from home before tucking to the two path half a mile out, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, rallied in concert with PROJECTED to his inside through the stretch offering up a mild kick to procure the show honors. MR HAVERCAMP saved ground just off the pace, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home and offered up a mild bid along the inside. DISCO PARTNER bumped at the start by VOODOO SONG who veered inwards, settled two to three wide just off the pace, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid to the eighth pole between foes before flattening out in the final furlong. BLIND AMBITION fell to his face at the start, recovered to be forwardly placed in the two path in closest aim of the leader, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three then two wide for home straightened away, remained prominent to the furlong grounds, then weakened in the final eighth. POCKET CHANGE bobbed at the start, settled just off the inside near the rear, came under coaxing tucked inside three furlongs out, swung three wide into upper stretch and made no impact.
