NICKNAME coaxed from the start, raced five wide early on just off the pace and to the outside of the leader in the four path, tucked four wide into the turn as the leader took to the three path, came under coaxing past the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch issuing a challenge and took command straightened for home, edged clear under a drive to the wire. NEMORALIA chased the pace three wide the innermost of the field early on, tucked to the rail nine-sixteenths from home and rode the inside through the turn to the five-sixteenths, angled out put to urging to be four to five wide into upper stretch, dug in under an off sided stick shying in just inside the eighth pole while offering a mild kick to be along for the place honors. SHE'S ALL READY coaxed from the start, cut the pace four then three wide through the turn, came under urging as NICKNAME intensified the pressure nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide at that station under threat, got headed straightened away, kept on to the sixteenth marker before weakening in the late going while well clear of the rest for the show. WIDTH rated four to five wide early on in pursuit just off the pace, tucked to the two path into the turn at the nine-sixteenths, came under urging with five-sixteenths to run, continued just off the inside for home and tired in the stretch. DESERT TUNE chased the pace five wide early on before taking to the three path into the turn, came under a ride three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, had the rider lose the handle on the whip nearing the eighth pole and tired in the drive. ANNA RAE four to five wide at the rear early on, came under prolonged coaxing half a mile from home, took the overland route through the turn and continued six wide into upper stretch, made no impact. WHERE'S THE D coaxed at the start, was forwardly placed six wide early on, backed away nearing the half mile pole, chased four wide through the turn urged along from the seven-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch, faltered and was not persevered with in the final eighth.
