1 MILE. (1:32) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 Go for Wand H.A HANDICAP FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$3,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday November 14, 2015 with 19 Nominations. (Clear 60)

Bay Filly, (May), by Flatter - Comedy by Theatrical (IRE). Trainer Simon Callaghan. Bred by Claiborne Farm & Adele B. Dilschneider (KY).

TARIS three wide in range of the leader in hand, came under light coaxing half a mile from home, chased through the turn, drifted out five wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, edged away under a drive to prevail. MEI LING four wide in range of the front, came under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home, got floated six wide into upper stretch, ran on to procure the place honors. SPELLING AGAIN coaxed from the gate, cut the pace just off the inside under the watchful eye of TARIS to the outside, got set down at the head of the stretch, dug in under a drive under threat from a pair, got headed outside the eighth pole, weakened in the late stages while clear for the show honors. KISS TO REMEMBER two to three wide in pursuit, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, continued two to three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. AMERICA three to four wide near the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, made no impact. WILLET chased the pace along the inside under urging from the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch, weakened in the lane. PLAYFUL LOVE just off the inside in pursuit from near the rear, came under a ride three furlongs from home, spun three wide at the quarter pole, offered no response.
