PLATINUM LADY broke out at the start, chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong, gamely turned away the challenge of the runner-up at the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. LADY GRANTHAM broke a bit slow, tossed her head while moving into the middle of the field, went two to three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed strongly into the final furlong, loomed a threat into the final sixteenth but was turned away while just able to get the place. WIND CHILL FACTOR was well spotted towards the front, came under urging while inside on the turn, was asked for her best in upper stretch, chased into the final sixteenth, moved out late and just missed the place. DEBBIE ANN angled in towards the rear, saved ground on the turn, moved out at the furlong marker and reached her best stride too late while improving position. TEELFA bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and failed to rally. FANCY MADELYN was fractious behind the gate, bumped with a rival at the start, disputed the pace on the inside of a rival, vied in the two path on the turn and gave way. CAJUN MAID was urged along while off the pace, raced in the two path on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and failed to threaten. ALIVIA'S LION bumped with an opponent at the start and was off a bit slow, raced on the far outside while urged along, went four to five wide on the turn and was no factor. JACKSON'S G G was urged along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, was taken in hand while off heels outside the furlong marker and never reached contention. SNAPPY GIRL had her stall door opened well behind the rest of the field, hit the front of the gate, came out at least six lengths slow, moved out while urged along, went three to four wide on the turn, dropped in at the three-sixteenths and also was no factor. VIVIAN DA BLING bumped with a rival at the start, disputed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and tired. ANOTHER PINOT was ridden along in the front half of the field, went three wide on the turn and had nothing left.
