6 FURLONGS. (1:08) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Louisiana Champions Day Sprint S.FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Early bird nominations closed October 1, 2015 at \$150. Final closing on December 1, 2015 at \$500. \$400 to enter; \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 122 lbs; Older- 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes in 2015 allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 twice in 2015 allowed 4 lbs. Non-winners of three races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2015 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Louisiana Chammions Day Sprint will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2015. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations Closed Tuesday, December 1, 2015 with 16. (Clear 80)

JOCKAMO'S SONG settled on the outside, was asked while three to four wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. TOO DIM bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, gained into the final furlong under a drive, altered course to the outside from behind foes at the sixteenth-pole and finished with good courage for the place. HEITAI broke out and bumped with a rival, showed his usual natural speed, opened up a sizable advantage, raced inside on the turn, was roused at the three-sixteenths, led under the whip into the final furlong but weakened while just able to get the show. SKIP THE PINOT settled on the outside, was urged along while four then three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly to just miss the show. CAJUN SILVER was a tad slow into stride, raced well back in the field, came five wide into the stretch and improved position. LOUISIANA FLYBOY broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field, came three wide into the stretch and was no factor. KING BANDIT broke through the gate prior to the start, was brought back around and reloaded, raced near the rail on the turn, came into the stretch in the two path and never reached contention. TOP CAT BOOGIE was urged along on the outside, went three wide on the turn and came up empty. SIR GENGHIS was urged along on the inside of a rival, raced in the two path on the turn and capitulated. Following the race, the rider of TOO DIM claimed foul against JOCKAMO'S SONG for alleged interference at the sixteenth-pole. After the stewards' review, there was no change made to the order of finish.
