Chestnut Gelding, (Apr), by Ghostzapper - Hot Talent by Alphabet Soup. Trainer Andrew Leggio, Jr.. Bred by Ronald P. Webb (LA).

HOT ZAPPER went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, hesitated when the loose came by at the five-eighths pole, chased three wide on the far turn, pursued the leader under the whip into the final furlong, made a bid on the inside of rivals at the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. STRING KING moved out early, was bumped by the loose horse into the turn and forced seven wide, dropped to the four path late on that bend, moved up on the outside with five furlongs to run, advanced four wide under urging on the far turn, chased under the whip in upper stretch, made a bid at the eighth-pole, held a slim advantage into the final sixteenth but was denied in a good effort. HOPEFUL NOTION had BENWILL clip his heels early, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was briefly taken in hand at the five-eighths pole, went around the far turn in the two path, shifted three wide into the stretch, moved out while put to a drive, rallied on the outside, closed well to make a bid inside the furlong marker, battled determinedly to the wire and also just missed. MCGEHEE'S MERCY went to the front, set the pace while off the rail, was taken up briefly when the loose horse went by at the five-eighths, raced in the two path on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, drifted out some at the furlong marker, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished. FOUR LEAF CHIEF bumped with a rival at the start, was taken up when BENWILL lost the rider in front of him early, raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while near the rail on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, moved into a reasonable striking range while on the far outside but flattened out. GALLERY lugged out into the first turn then was bumped in the hindquarters by the loose horse and taken up some, was in the three path at that point then dropped to the rail, settled off the pace under some restraint, saved ground on the far turn, hugged the rail in upper stretch while lacking optimal clearance, steadied inside the furlong marker and failed to threaten. WELL'S GOLD was well placed on the inside, chased along the rail on the far turn, pursued the vanguard under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. BENWILL bumped with a rival at the start, clipped heels early and stumbled then lost the rider. (Rail at 16 Feet)
