1 1/4 MILE. (1:42) STAKES. Purse \$75,000 Louisiana S.FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, December 30. \$375 to enter; \$375 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over since November 13 allowed 2 lbs., \$25,000 at a mile or over since October 13 allowed 4 lbs., \$20,000 of such a race since then allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Louisiana Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference will be given in the following manner: graded or group winners in order (I, II, III), then highest lifetime earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or the supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations Closed Saturday, December 30, 2017 with 26 nominations. (Clear 41)

CEDARTOWN bumped with a rival at the start, rounded the first turn in the two path, was rated just off the pace, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, shook clear in upper stretch and proved best under steady handling. SCUBA went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, rounded the far turn in the two path while still in hand, was asked while three wide into the stretch, moved out at the three-sixteenths and finished willingly to just get the place. HAWAAKOM settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and also finished willingly but just missed the place. THE PLAYER bumped with a foe at the start, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the two path on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and was outfinished. SHUT THE BOX raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace in hand, vied inside on the far turn, was asked once straightened for the drive, lost the advantage near the three-sixteenths and weakened. COOPTADO (ARG) broke a step slow, traveled around the first turn in the two path, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SEATTLE SERENADE went four wide on the first turn, settled outside under some urging, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn, spun five wide into the stretch and came up empty. GUEST SUITE stumbled at the start, went three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and was no factor. DECEMBER SEVEN went five wide on the first turn, settled well back on the outside, raced four then three wide on the far turn and showed little.
