LA SARDANE (FR) away well, quickly established control, showed the way from along the inside route, coaxed and facing mild pressure from the THAIS positioned to the outside, continued along under the same set up for the opening three-quarters, stepped into the lane with several others under encouragement of varying degrees by this huncture, yet remained on hold herself, got asked for more once PAS DE SOUCIS hitched up, this occurring deep into the furlong grounds, had enough run to fend both that foe off, in addition to the second place finisher. IN THE LEE guided onto the inside route shortly after the start, abandoned it once PRINCESS GIBRALTAR settled along it, departed the backstretch switched over to light urging, began to tip to the outside leaving the five-sixteenths marker in preparation for the drive home, got roused working her way into path four from upper to midlane, came home with home with good energy to garner the place. PAS DE SOUCIS (IRE) underwent a three wide journey, was given its cue as six furlongs was being reached, crept up during the going from the top of the lane to midstretch, failed to claim the lead then lost out on second. PRINCESS GIBRALTAR (FR) along the outside during the initial stages, was moved over to the hedge about midpoint on the backstretch, was forced to remain well in hand, idling behind FEELING BOSSY during the final stages of the run around the fuller bend, stepped into the lane and soon found room to swing to the outside, did just that, getting roused, completed the maneuver towards path three, made no headway in the last eighth and had to settle for the final significant slice of the pot. FEELING BOSSY came up empty following a ground-saving journey. THAIS (FR) hung out three wide heading for the top of the backstretch, stalked the winner closer to the hedge afterwards, kept at it for six furlongs before giving way. LIDO two wide and between rivals on the turn, commenced the stretch slightly wider, made no impact.
