STALLWALKIN' DUDE raced up close just of NEWFOUND GAL then moved up and took over lead in hand three furlongs out, quickly put under pressure from TROUBLE KID, vied along inside of rival in the stretch, had slight lead over rival, kept on gamely and prevailed. TROUBLE KID tracked pace in early stages, gained ground leaving the backstretch, edged up closer along outside of STALLWALKIN' DUDE at five sixteenths pole, continued to duel for lead in the lane, raced under left handed urging in final furlong but lacked needed kick to get by. ROCKINN ON BYE was unhurried and raced off the pace in the backstretch, picked up pace along the inside then angled out path and raced between rivals at quarter pole, continued steady bid for top two leaders in the lane, could not catch rivals and secured clear third. GRANDE SHORES was allowed to settle back running through the backstretch, made two wide move midway in the far turn, lacked room at quarter pole, swung to outside in the turn, gained ground between rivals in final furlong. ONE MORE NIGHT raced in the back of the field, saved ground and gained ground along the rail, lacked racing room entering the top of the lane, shifted out three wide and improved position in the lane. CLASSIC SALSA was rated up close along the inside, lacked racing room in the far turn, angled out at quarter pole, continued five wide bid in upper stretch then flattened out in late drive. OLD TIMES SAKE raced mid-pack along inside in the backstretch, hustled up in the far turn, raced between rivals at top of the lane then shifted back to rail and had no late kick. LEDOKOL raced far back, made up some ground but lacked needed rally to move into contention. GRYVON raced along outside and had no kick in the drive. NEWFOUND GOLD vied for early lead racing along inside of eventual winner, could not keep up pace, gaveway in the lane. TRICKY CALL raced in early contention then quickly dropped back at the five sixteenths pole.
