BEACH PATROL stalked the pace three wide up the backstretch, moved to even terms leaving the second turn, obtained a narrow lead in upper stretch and dueled the remainder, holding sway to narrowly best LONG ISLAND SOUND, who attended the pace of SCISSORS AND TAPE, moved to a brief and narrow lead leaving the far turn then dueled gamely inside BEACH PATROL but was simply second best today. AMERICAN PATRIOT settled in behind along the rail through the early going, was urged along at the half-mile pole to take closer order inside foes and did so into the second turn, came out three wide turning into the stretch and was all out till safely securing show honors. ONE MEAN MAN tracked the leaders mid-pack inside early, came out a path up the backstretch, went two to three wide between foes on the far turn and urged along two furlongs out, came out a path in upper stretch and kicked on mildly. OSCAR NOMINATED settled between rivals off the early pace into the first turn, lost ground up the backstretch outside, forced three wide into the second turn, checked near the quarter pole when in tight before angling out four then five wide leaving that bend and gained belatedly. CORDON was taken back early settling last but one shifting in heading down the home straight the first time, continued off but near the inside into the stretch and improved position. SURGICAL STRIKE forced three wide on the first turn, made a brief bid three then four wide on the far turn but flattened out in the stretch. CHERRY WINE settled at the rear, swung six wide and had no bid. SCISSORS AND TAPE set the pace inside, faded through the stretch.
