1 1/4 MILE. (1:464) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 Sunshine Millions Classic S. FLORIDA-BRED FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, January 6. \$2,000 to enter. \$200,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over since July 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race at a mile or over since July 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. (Clear 77)

SOUPER TAPIT was a step slow at the start and four wide rounding the first turn, advanced to a stalking position outside JAY'S WAY and WEISSER up the backstretch, shifted inward putting the latter in a bit tight past the five-sixteenths as he ranged up to challenge outside JAY'S WAY, took over in upper stretch and was resolute to maintain control through the final stages. JAY'S WAY grabbed the early lead in the two-path, shifted inside rating along through an even tempo, got hooked from the outside by SOUPER TAPIT a quarter-mile out, and fought on tenaciously along the rail to the wire. DALMORE was outsprinted to the lead inside JAY'S WAY after the start, eased back and steadied reluctant to settle coming off the first turn, remained hemmed in until cautiously maneuvered out three wide finally with a clear shot approaching the stretch, and did not have enough outside the top two. TRANSISTOR raced in the second flight two wide early, saved ground advancing into the far turn, and flattened out in the drive. FOREVAMO saved ground in range early, went two then three wide on the far turn, and lacked a solid response. NOBLE DRAMA trailed three to four wide entering the backstretch, and failed to make his presence felt. MR. JORDAN brushed with WEISSER at the start, tussled with the rider briefly tossing his head about going to the first turn, raced three to four wide throughout and was no threat. WEISSER brushed with MR. JORDAN at the start, prompted the pace outside, steadied between SOUPER TAPIT and DALMORE past the five-sixteenths, and retreated.
