1M70YDS. (1:41) STAKES. Purse \$75,000 Tenacious S.FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, December 2. \$375 to enter; \$375 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weights: Three Year Old - 121 lbs; Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over since October 16 allowed 2 lbs, \$35,000 at a mile or over since September 16 allowed 4 lbs, \$25,000 at a mile or over since then allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Tenacious Stakes will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference will be given in the following manner: graded or group winners in order (I, II, III), then highest lifetime earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed on Saturday, December 2, 2017 with 22. (Cloudy 52)

Bay Gelding, (Sep), by Equal Stripes (ARG) - Coordinada (ARG) by Ride the Rails. Trainer Thomas Morley. Bred by Abolengo (ARG).

COOPTADO (ARG) rounded the first turn in the two path, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging while against the rail on the far turn, chased under the whip into the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole, battled with the runner-up to the wire and narrowly prevailed under vigorous handling. SHUT THE BOX went three wide on the first turn, was rated under a strong hold on the far outside, ranged up while three to four wide on the far turn, made a bid outside the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, inched clear at the three-sixteenths, led into the final sixteenth, battled with the winner to the wire and was denied. LEOFRIC rounded the first turn in the two path, lagged at the rear, was urged along while inside on the far turn, gained while cutting the corner into the stretch, moved into a good striking range along the rail into the final furlong and finished with good courage for the show while unable to reach the top two. STICKSSTATELYDUDE broke out at the start, saved ground on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, vied inside early on the far turn then drifted to the two path, floated three wide into the stretch and weakened. MONEY FLOWS went around the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FIELD OF COURAGE went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked while two to three wide on the far turn, spun four wide into the stretch and came up empty. FAR RIGHT saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the back, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to rally.
