By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 2017 or two Grade II races in 2017 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade I in 2016 or a Grade II in 2017 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Grade III allowed 6 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 22, 2017 with 21 Nominations. (Clear 78)**

**Bay Filly, (Apr), by Concord Point - American Story by Ghostzapper. Trainer Simon Callaghan. Bred by Kaleem Shah, Inc. (KY).**

**AMERICAN GAL** broke out at the start and was corrected, got lightly coaxed along five wide down the backstretch in range of the front, advanced in tandem with **FAYPIEN** to her inside to engage the top pair through the turn, vied four wide stacked outside a trio through the bend under urging past the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive to take command just outside the eighth pole, edged clear under a drive to prevail. **FAYPIEN** bumped at the start by **DIVINE MISS GREY** who broke outwards, got coaxed along four wide in aim of the early duel, advanced with seven-sixteenths to go in tandem with the aforementioned foe to her outside to engage the duelers, vied three wide through the turn between rivals under urging from the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive unable to match the top one late while running on to secure the place honors over a surging late rival. **TEQUILITA** fractious in the gate prior to the start inspired to it by **DIVINE MISS GREY** and **VERTICAL OAK** who grew a bit fractious just prior, chased three wide from just off the pace, came under coaxing three furlongs out between foes as a second flight stacked behind the top one through the turn, angled five wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly and missed for the place honors latching on the aforementioned rival as that one hit the finish. **CHALON** established the front shortly after the start and duelled inside under coaxing with **VERTICAL OAK** to her outside, got joined by an additional pair seven-sixteenths out and vied inside a trio through the turn under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside for home clinging to the front, got headed just outside the eighth pole and weakened in the final eighth to the finish. **VERTICAL OAK** bobbed at the break brushing the off side stall, led early on before dueling with the aforementioned foe to her inside under light coaxing from the two path, got joined by a pair outside with seven-sixteenths to go, vied just off the inside between foes through the turn, swung three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong. **YOUR LOVE** three then two wide near the rear of the field, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch and improved position in the drive. **DIVINE MISS GREY** a bit fractious prior to the start, chased five wide down the backstretch before briefly stacked four wide among a quartet just off the pace dispute up front through the turn, got coaxed along three furlongs from home, faded through the latter portion of the bend, swung five wide at the quarter pole and offered no response. **CHANEL'S LEGACY** six wide down the backstretch, chased four to five wide through the turn stacked outside a trio, came under encouragement at the three-eighths, swung six wide for home and made no headway. **MINNIE BLIP** just off the pace in pursuit just off the inside, tucked to the rail half a mile from home, came under coaxing inside a trio midway on the turn, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. **CURSOR** chased just off the inside detached at the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, angled six wide at the quarter pole and made no impact trailing throughout.
