6½ FURLONGS. (1:14²) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Victory Ride S.FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEARS-OLD. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,250 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided \$87,000 to the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth, \$3,000 to sixth and \$3,000 divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$120,000 or \$60,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; of \$90,000 in 2016 allowed 4 lbs.; of \$60,000 allowed 6 lbs., of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races in 2016 allowed 8 lbs; of such a race in 2016 allowed 10 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 25, 2016 with 23 Nominations. (Cloudy 73)

COPPA came away from the gate without apparent mishap, settled into a forward position, sat perched in three path keeping watch on the front runners, made her presence felt all the more by hitching up to them as the half was being completed, remained on hold the remainder of the run to the head of the stretch, step foot into the lane and was switched over to stronger handling, fought fiercely to take over during the ensuing furlong, never fully shook free, dug in gamely in the final stages to stave off a pair of closers to preserve the decision. MALIBU STACY narrowly broke on top, responded to the rider's touch and dropped back into midpack, departed the backstretch placed in the three path, sat well reserved within striking distance of the front runners, spun four wide into the stretch and having settled in got called upon, closed enough real estate by the beginning of the last eighth to loom a threat, maintained the momentum en route to garnering place honors. ONE TRUE KISS took up the chase from the two path, picked up interest in short order after entering the turn, got angled three wide for the drive home, arrived at the furlong marker with a good turn of foot, split foes in deep stretch rallying for third. LOST RAVEN pressed the issue from the two path, was forced to undertake the task from between opponents beginning from the five-sixteenths marker once the eventual winner burst upon the scene, put up an inspiring fight until the general area of the sixteenth marker then tired. FLATTERYWILLGETYOU tucked into the pocket after the break, lacked usable options heading for the quarter pole, stuck behind a wall that grown to number a total of four, slithered out towards the three path and after having done so, responded positively when given her cue, altered course towards a temporary opening between rivals in the two path nearing the sixteenth pole, was forced to take hold after it tightened up, failed to regain any interest afterwards. BEHRNIK'S BANK vied from the rail for command, had the top one add herself to the pace picture approaching the five-sixteenths pole, got asked for run soon afterwards, kept up the fight inside two others for the next quarter before giving way. BLAST put to some light hand encouragement after the start, saved ground to upper stretch and failed to menace.
