1 1/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:38¹) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 With Anticipation S.FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 120 lbs. Non-winners of a race on the turf other than claiming allowed 2 lbs.; all maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The NYRA reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the graded stakes committee. Closed Saturday, August 19, 2017 with 27 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, Two-Year-Old races will be run at Seven Furlongs and races for Three-Year-Olds and Up will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.). CATHOLIC BOY got bumped and pinched between foes shortly after the start as EARTH veered in, settled saving ground in mid pack, remained patiently handled in behind foes through the far turn and was nudged by FORT WISE TREATY near the five-sixteenths, remained on hold in a bit of traffic nearing upper stretch, darted out sharply filling a gap left by the backing away FORT WISE TREATY to the three path straightened away for home following IRISH TERRITORY, leaned on UNTAMED DOMAIN to get some clearance to angle a path out a furlong from home, rallied to issue a challenge a sixteenth out, took command nearing the finish and inched away in the late stages to the wire. IRISH TERRITORY (IRE) coaxed from the gate, raced three then two wide through the opening bend before settling three to four deep in mid pack, came under light coaxing at the three-eighths, swung two to three wide for home knocking heads with EARTH for the front and taking command a furlong out, dug in under a drive, got collared inside the final sixteenth while along safe for the place honors. UNTAMED DOMAIN lunged at the start, settled three to four wide near the rear, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, continued four wide for home, closed well getting nudged and leaned on a furlong from home as CATHOLIC BOY leaned outwards for a little clearance along his inside and was along to secure the show honors. SEABHAC just off the inside in mid pack, came under light coaxing five-sixteenths from home, was forced to steady off the heels of the backing away FORT WISE TREATY at the quarter pole before altering out to swing five wide straightened away for home, then offered up a mild kick to secure the last major share. EARTH veered in at the start bumping CATHOLIC BOY and pinching that foe back against NAUTI BUOY who he came together with solidly knocking that rival off stride and askew as well as into MORRISON, showed the way a bit keen in the first turn under rating before settling in hand just off the inside down the backstretch, came under light coaxing under pressure for the initial time nearing the five-sixteenths, cut the corner head to head with IRISH TERRITORY, dueled until nearing the eighth pole and was headed just outside that station, then weakened in the late stages. MORRISON got bumped after the start by NAUTI BUOY due to pressure from the aforementioned foe, saved ground near the rear, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch in and among rivals, offered up a mild bid to improve position through to the finish. EVALUATOR off to a hesitant start requiring the rider to utilize an off sided stick, settled just off the inside at the tail of the field, came under urging angled out five to six wide midway on the far turn, continued six wide into upper stretch and could not make an impact. TRUMPI just off the inside through the first turn, raced forwardly placed four wide down the backstretch before being tucked three wide with three furlongs to go, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. NAUTI BUOY got bumped solidly off stride and askew shortly after the start by EARTH who veered inwards and in turn bumped MORRISON, tracked the pace from the two path in range of the front, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner briefly paused into upper stretch and weakened through to the finish. MACHTREE three to four wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four then three wide straightened away for home and weakened in the stretch. FORT WISE TREATY chased just off the pace three wide under encouragement from the five-sixteenths, began to back away nearing the quarter pole, swung two to three wide at that station and tired.
