

Capsheet Guide for Upgrading from V3.x to V4.0

This document applies **ONLY** to users who are upgrading from Capsheet V3.x to Capsheet V4.0.

How to Preserve Gambling Recordkeeping Created with V3.x

After you install V4.0, you may copy your V3.x Capmoney Files into the folder where V4.0 is installed. This will preserve the time and effort you invested to build these Gambling Recordkeeping files.

Capmoney filename patterns are:

- <CAPMyyyy.WGR> where <yyyy> is year.
- <CAPMyyyy.W2G> where <yyyy> is year.

Copy **only** these files from the V3.x folder to the V4.0 folder (e.g., from C:\CAPSYS30 to C:\C4SYSTEM). **Sample** Capmoney files for 1990 were installed with V4.0; you may allow the copy function to replace these newer files with your older 1990 sample files from V3.x. Perform the following procedure **after** you copy your files to V4.0:

1. Start/Run Capsheet **V4.0**.
2. Select and run <Gambling Recordkeeping>.

Verify that all your annual financial totals are correct in V4.0. Repeat these instructions until you are sure that all V3.x Capmoney files exist in V4.0.

How to Preserve PP-Bias Files Created with V3.x

After you install V4.0, you may copy your V3.x PP-Bias Files (PPB) into the folder where V4.0 is installed. This will preserve the time and effort you invested to acquire PP-Bias statistics and create these files.

PP-Bias filename patterns are <CAPS_ttt.PPB> where <ttt> is track code.

Copy **only** these files from the V3.x folder to the V4.0 folder (e.g., from C:\CAPSYS30 to C:\C4SYSTEM). Some **sample** PP-Bias files were installed with V4.0; you should allow the copy function to replace these newer files with your own older files. Perform the following procedure **after** you copy your files to V4.0:

3. Start/Run Capsheet **V4.0**.
4. Select and run <Update Post-Position Biases>.

If any of the tracks for copied PP-Bias files are NOT in the Master Track List that is installed with V4.0, the program will display one or more error dialogs (i.e., PP-Bias File Track Code Is Unknown). Make a list of any unknown track codes, then add these track codes to the

Master Track List via procedure <Updates / Update Master Track List>. As you add each track code, the program will automatically recognize the corresponding PP-Bias file.

How to Un-Install Capsheet V3.x

You may un-install Capsheet V3.x via <**UninstallShield™ For Capsheet**>, which is located in your Start Menu group for Capsheet V3.x. Note that Capsheet V3.x must be un-installed via UninstallShield whereas Capsheet V4.x can be un-installed from the <Control Panel> via the Windows Add/Remove Software procedure.

Technically, you may un-install V3.x **before** or **after** you run CAPWIN40.EXE to install V4.0. However, we recommend that you get V4.0 up and running before un-installing V3.x.

Note that <UninstallShield™ For Capsheet> V3.x removes **ONLY** files that were originally installed with V3.x. Thus, if you un-install V3.x, all Capmoney and PP-Bias files that you created are **retained**. Therefore, un-installing V3.x may actually simplify the task of copying your Capmoney and PP-Bias files to V4.0.

As a final step, you may delete the Capsheet V3.x folder (e.g., C:\CAPSYS30) to recover all disk space that was used by V3.x. You may also delete any leftover Capsheet V3.x shortcuts that are missed by the un-install procedure. Do NOT remove new shortcuts for V4.0.

Major New Features in V4.0

V4.0 includes **major new features** which are documented in the **Capsheet V4.0 Product Summary** and throughout other documents in the new <Document Library>, in the <User's Guide>, and in the <Help> system. You can learn about these new features when you begin to use Capsheet V4.0.

Upgrade Changes

V4.0 includes numerous upgrade changes that are also documented throughout the system. Here is a **partial** list of the changes you will find in V4.0.

- The Windows Default Printer is now the default printer for Capsheet. This means that USB and other local/remote printer interfaces are now supported.
- Program Numbers, Morning Lines, and other track program data items are now captured from handicapping downloads that have been updated by BRIS. ETD-file updates are NOT needed unless you download racecards before BRIS has updated them with track program information. For Standard, Contest, and Custom Card downloads, any races that lack Program Numbers and Morning Lines are automatically listed when you <Translate CS4 Download(s) To Input(s)>.

- Actual track takeout percentages are now maintained in the Master Track List that is installed with V4.0. Capsheet odds use these takeout percentages, which you may update at any time. See procedure <Handicapping Setup Options> or <Update Post-Position Biases>.
- New handicapping factors have been introduced. You will notice some of them when you <View Handicapping Racecard Input(s)>. See document **Capsheet CS4 & CSI File Contents** for a complete list of all data items.
- **Graded Handicap Reports** and **Jockey/Trainer/Pedigree Reports** contain new information. See document **Handicapping Reports Reference Guide**.
- A new handicapping option allows you to control the sequence of horses presented in Turf, Dirt, and Mddy odds-lines of the Graded Handicap. See procedure <Handicapping Setup Options>.
- Plus many more enhancements. Whenever you see something new or different, trigger <Help> for an instant explanation.
