Race Summary

HIGH CHAPARRAL (IRE) tucked in behind the early leaders, was rated between horses for a mile, waited patiently for room while between horses on the turn, split rivals while just inside WITH ANTICIPATION to launched his bid at the top of the stretch, surged to the front in mid stretch then edged clear under brisk right hand urging. WITH ANTICIPATION taken in hand early, was unhurried for seven furlongs while four wide, continued wide while launching his bid on the turn then finished well from outside but couldn't overtake the winner. FALCON FLIGHT (FR) raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground along the backstretch, waited briefly for room along the inside through the turn, angled out to get clear in upper stretch then rallied belatedly. THE TIN MAN sprinted clear soon after the start, was shaken up while attempting to prop going under the wire the first time, set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, maintained a clear lead into upper stretch then weakened from his early efforts. DENON raced in close contention along the inside into upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. GOLAN (IRE) broke slowly, checked slightly along the inside entering the stretch the first time, trailed to the turn then lacked a strong closing response. BALLINGARRY (IRE) chased the pacesetter from outside to the top of the stretch and tired. PERFECT SOUL (IRE) moved into contention while four wide along the backstretch, raced within striking distance to the turn then faltered.

The conclusion: this horse's 2nd place finish is even stronger than it appears in the PPs. He was racing against the bias and lost to a horse loose on the lead. Now you can wager on the horse with more confidence, knowing something 99% of the public is unaware of.
